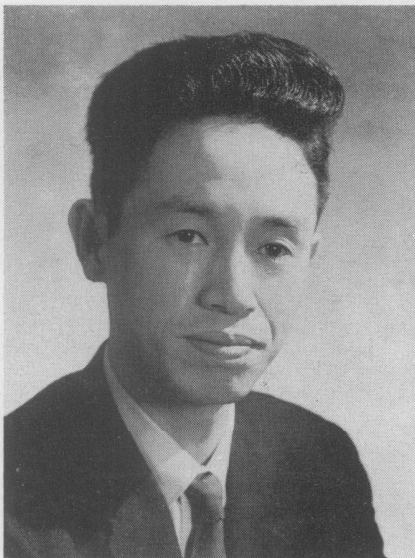
Founders Award

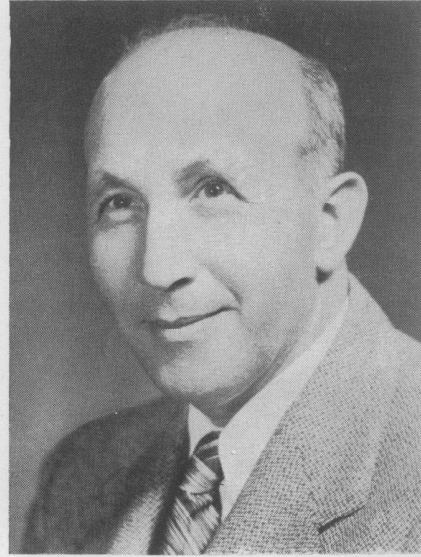
Memorial Prize Award in Memory of Morris N. Liebmann

For important contributions to the theory and technology of solid state devices, particularly as embodied in the tunnel diode.

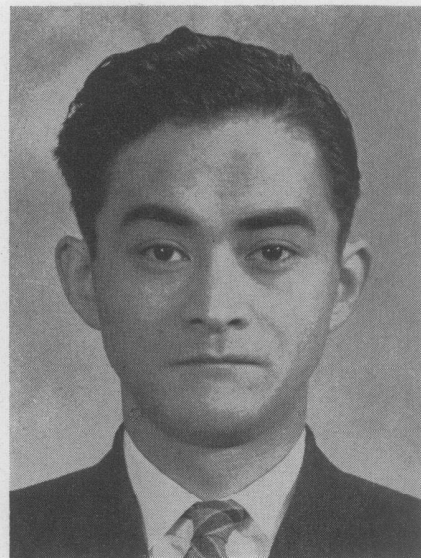
Medal of Honor Award
