

Final Comments from the Advocate

The two experts supported the proposal. The proposer has already made the modifications to the title as suggested and agreed with the following citation with the suggested minor changes:

In 1988, in the Laboratory of Intelligent Machines and Bioinformation Systems located in this building, signals emanating from a human brain controlled the movement of a physical object (a robot) for the first time worldwide. This linked EEG research with robotics, and opened a new communication channel between humans and machines. The EEG-controlled physical objects (wheelchairs, exoskeletons, etc) became reality, for the benefit of humanity.

Proposer agreed that he would approve that citation when needed in the procedure.

As an advocate, I approve this proposal moving forward for the IEEE History Committee's consideration.
